However, what I'm most proud of is that we're still a family business with strong values at our heart.

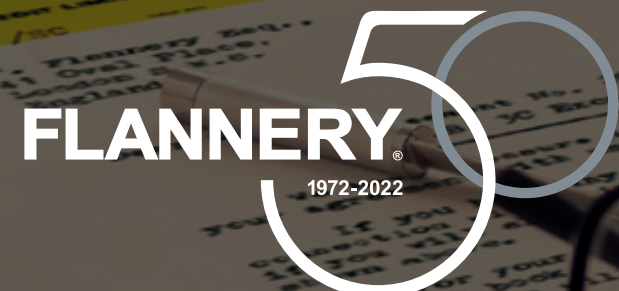
That's what has made us resilient and will stand us in good stead for the next 50 years.

Thank you to everybody who has made and continues to make us what we are today.

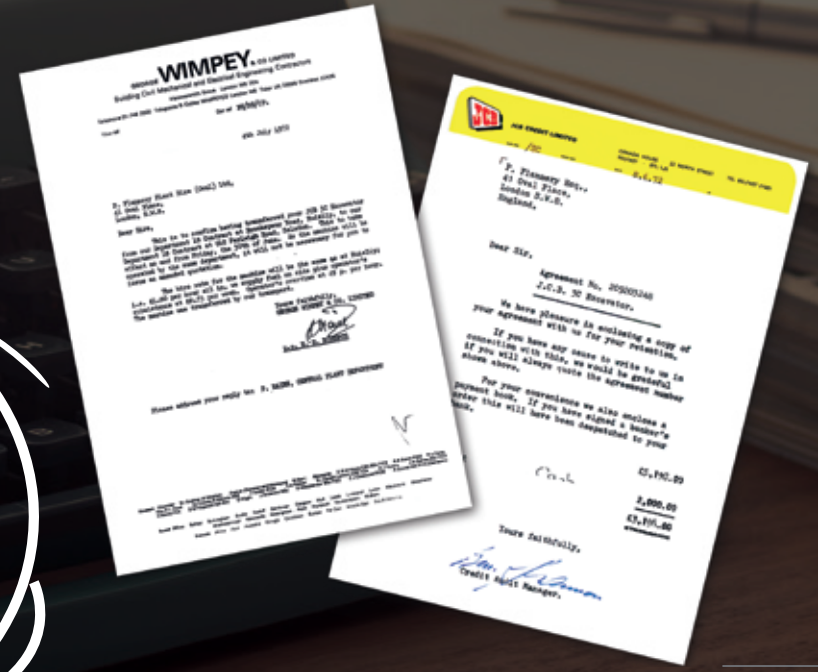

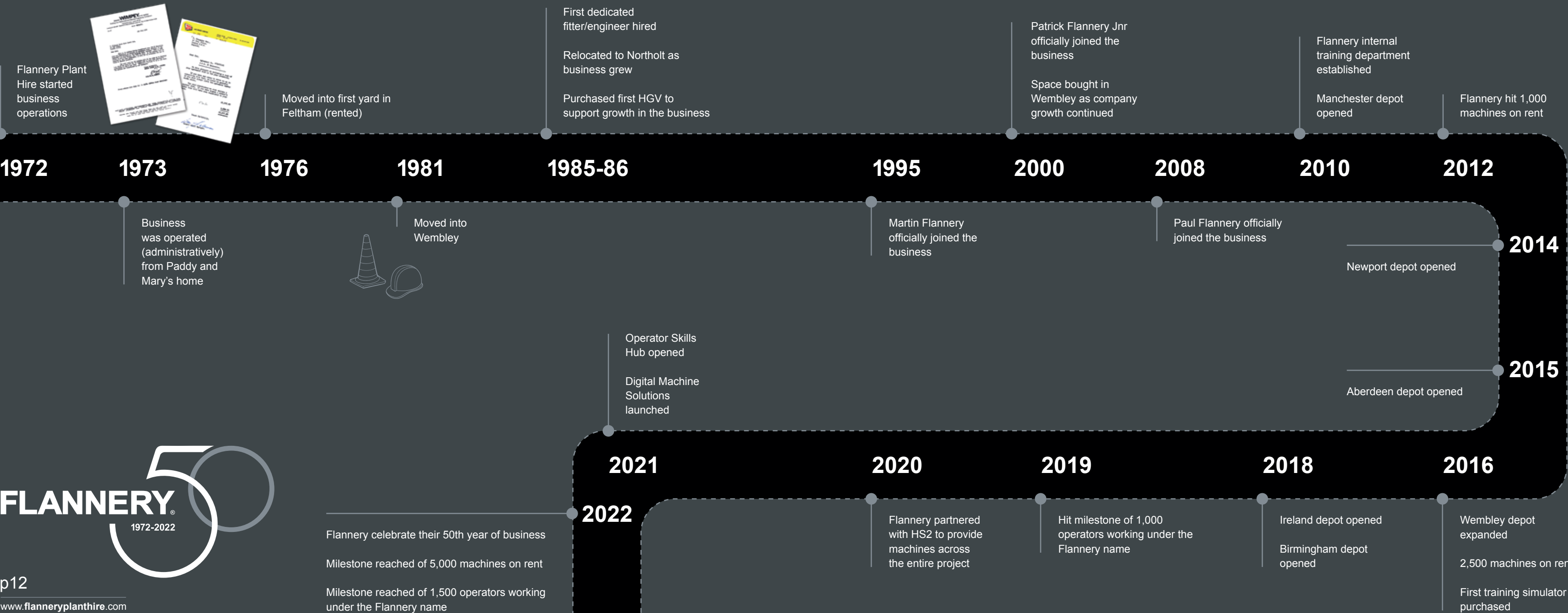
Flannery Plant Hire supported the build of the 2012 London Olympic Stadium.

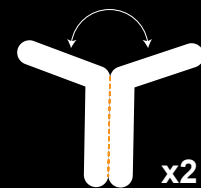
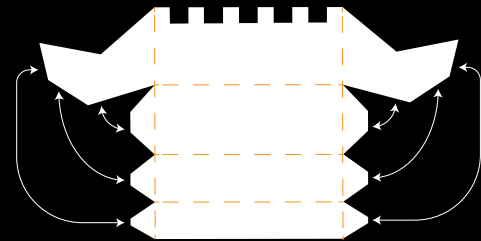
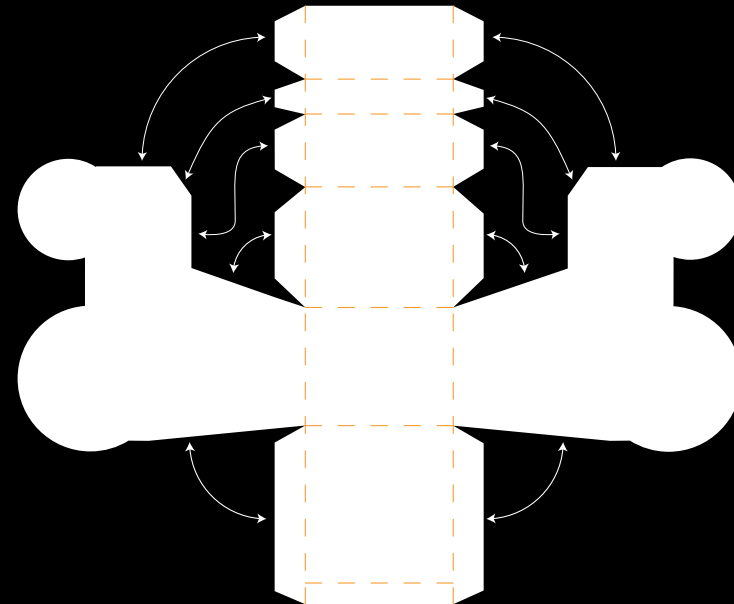
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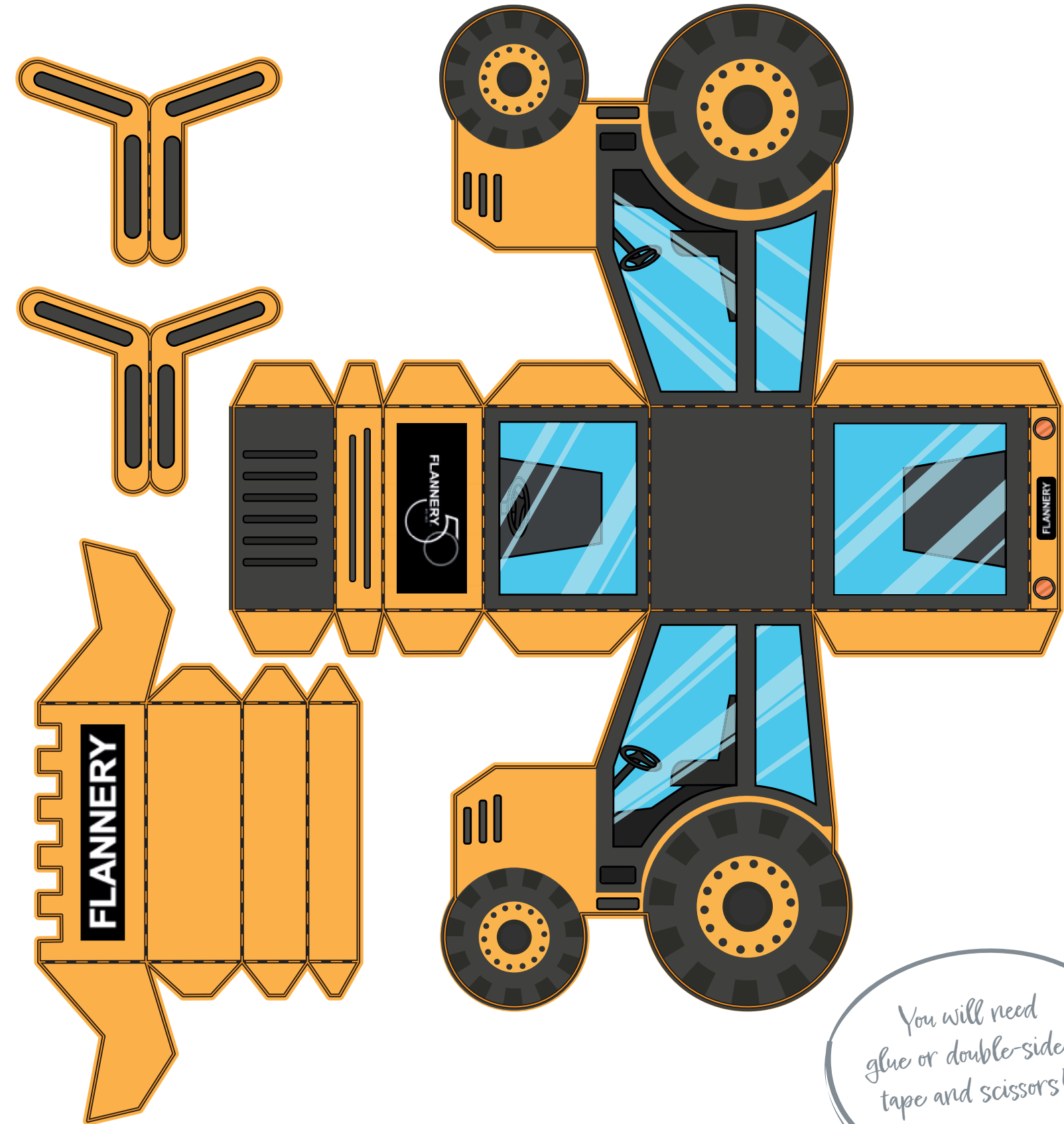
Make your own Flannery digger...

1. Push out the perforated pieces across the page.
2. Fold along the fold lines.
3. Secure flaps in place with glue or double-sided tape, see diagram for reference.
4. Attach digger arms to side of digger using glue or double-sided tape.
5. Complete your digger by securing the bucket in the arms (secure with glue or double-sided tape).
6. Place finished digger on your desk, and have fun!
